In compliance with the above policies, a Citizenship Verification Hold preventing course registration will be placed at the time of admission for any student admitted for fall 2011 or later until lawful presence is verified.	
Guidelines for Submission of Immigration Documents:  Incoming students who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents must provide International Student & Scholar Services (ISSS) with <a href="Legible">Legible</a> copies of their immigration documentation in order for their lawful presence to be verified. Such documents must include:  1. Copy of your passport ID page (all students must provide this) 2. Other documents appropriate to your immigration status:  • Valid I-94 card  • Approval notice from U.S. Citizenship & Immigration Services (USCIS)  • If U.S. permanent resident: Front & back color copy of Form I-551 (Permanent Resident Alien Card)  • If applicant for permanent residency: USCIS receipt notice (I-485)  [Note: An Employment Authorization Card alone is not sufficient for verification of status.]
