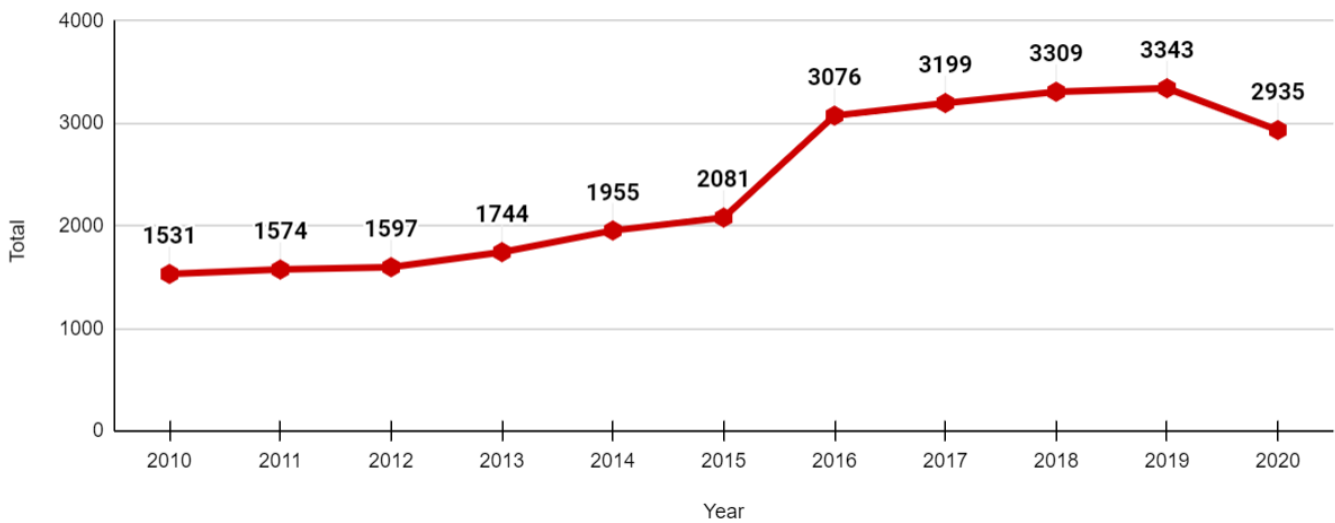
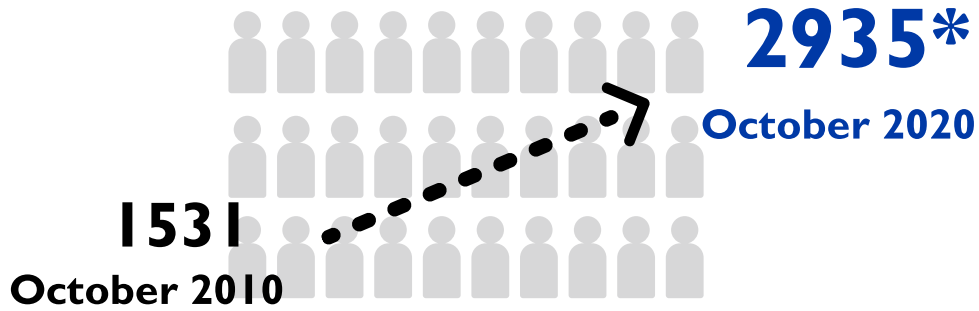

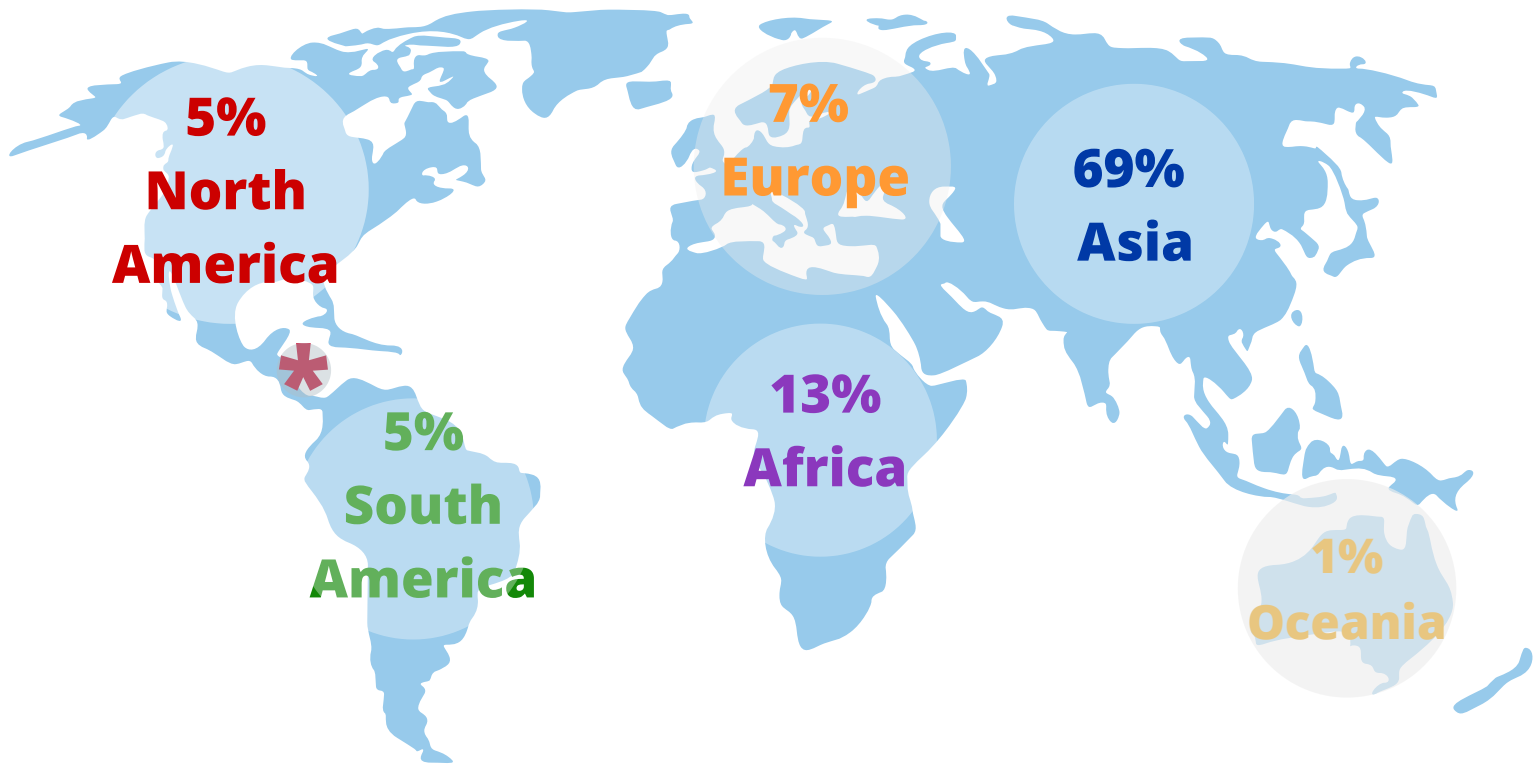

# Regional Origins



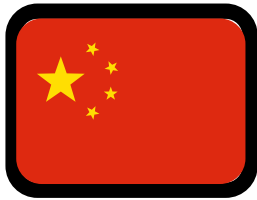

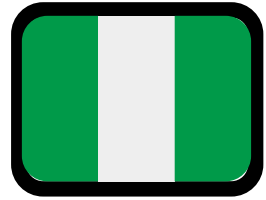

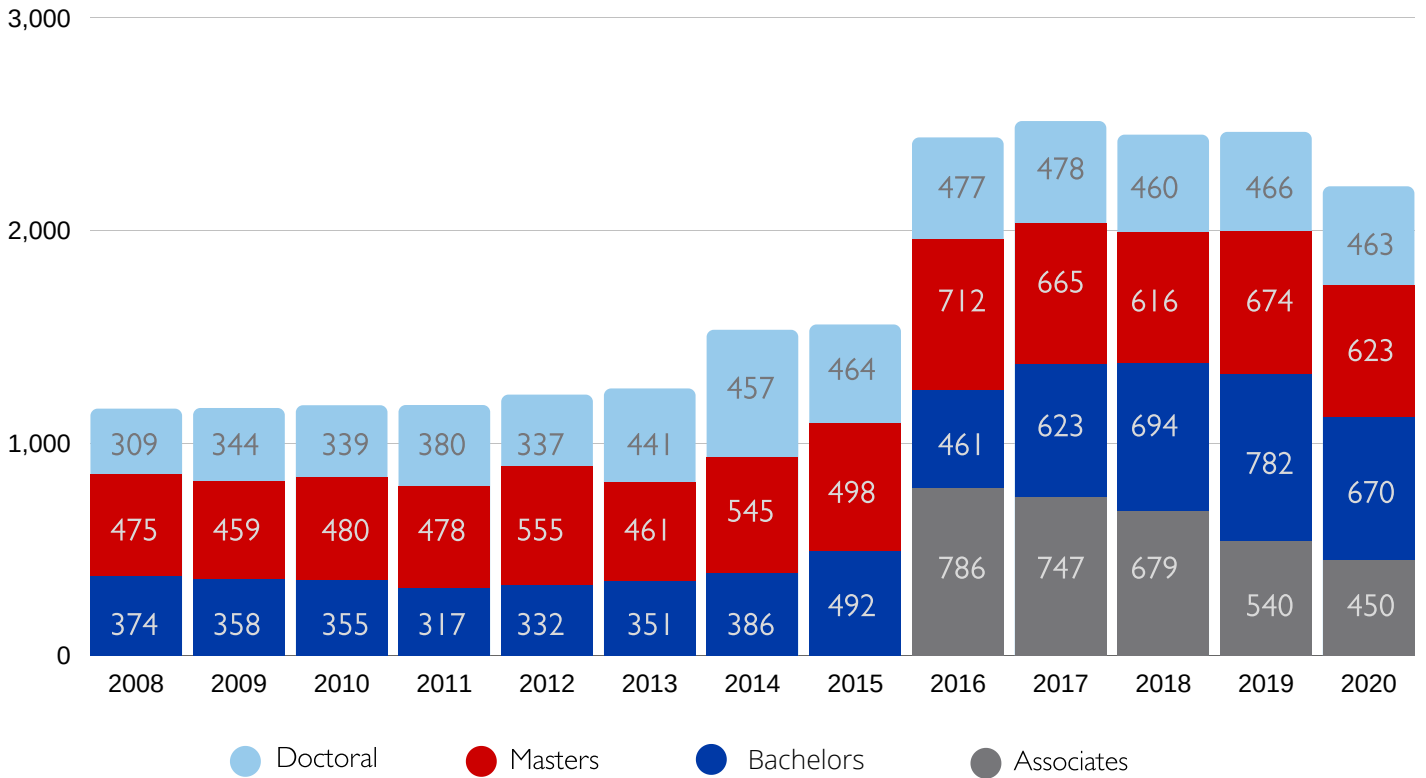

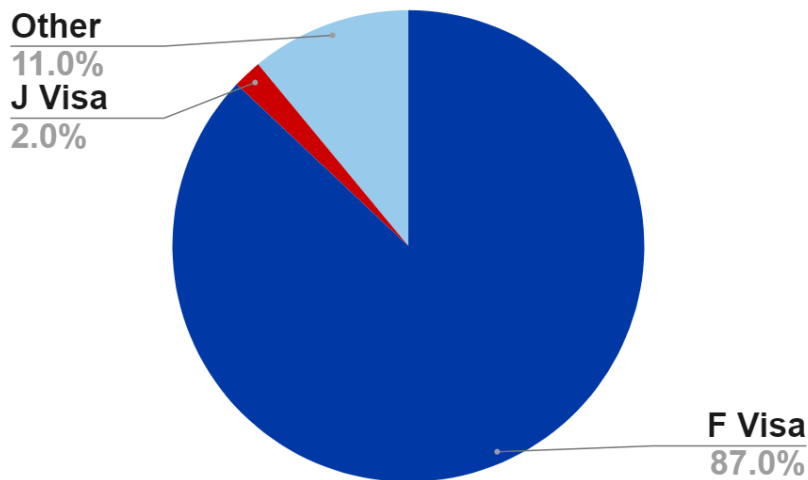

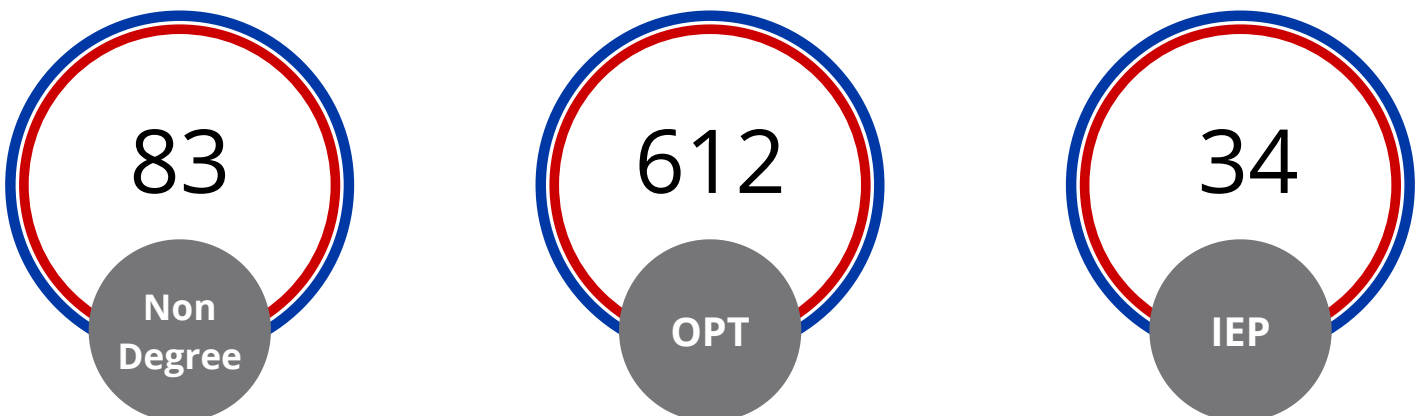
# International Enrollment By Academic Level



## By Visa Type

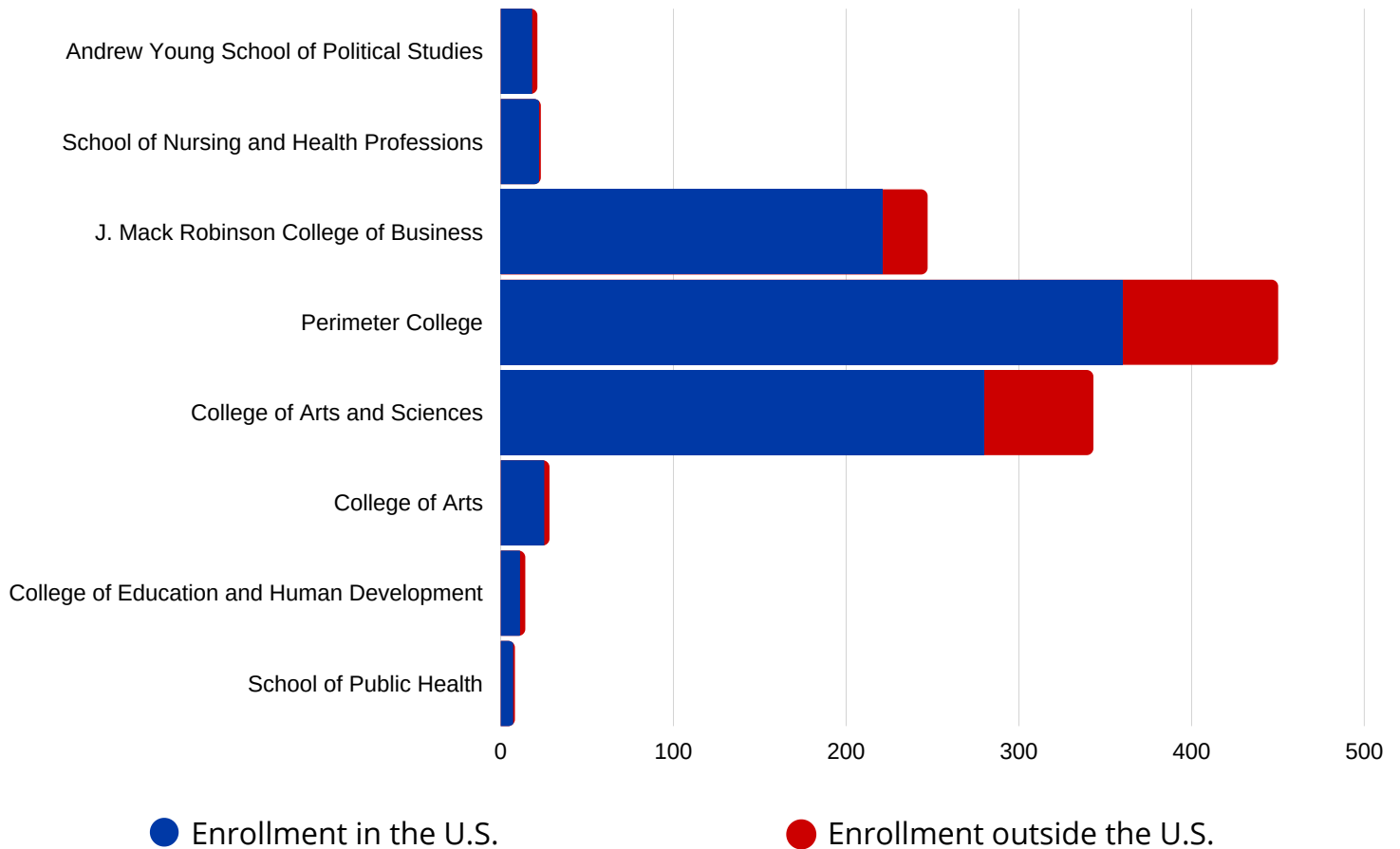

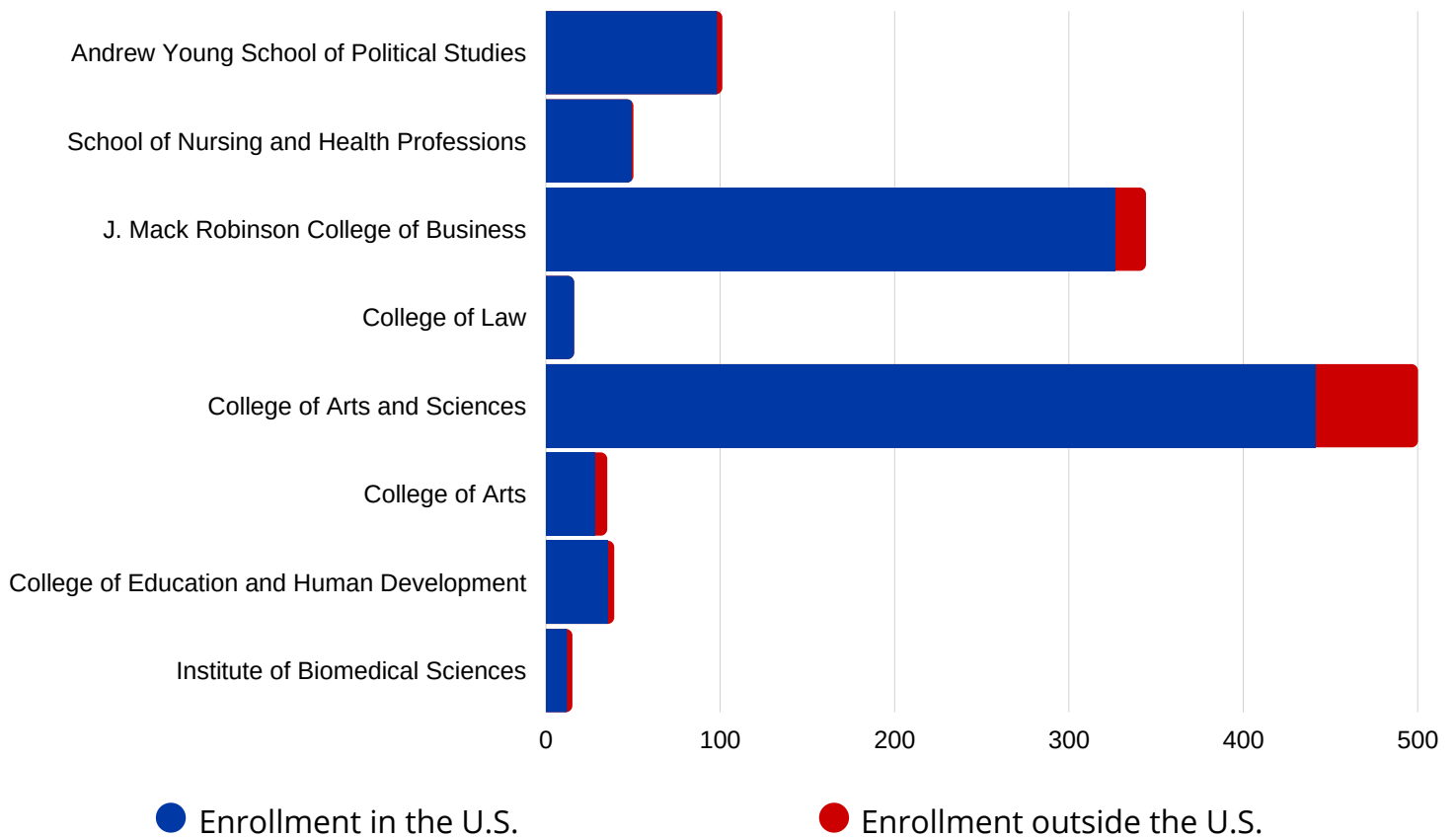

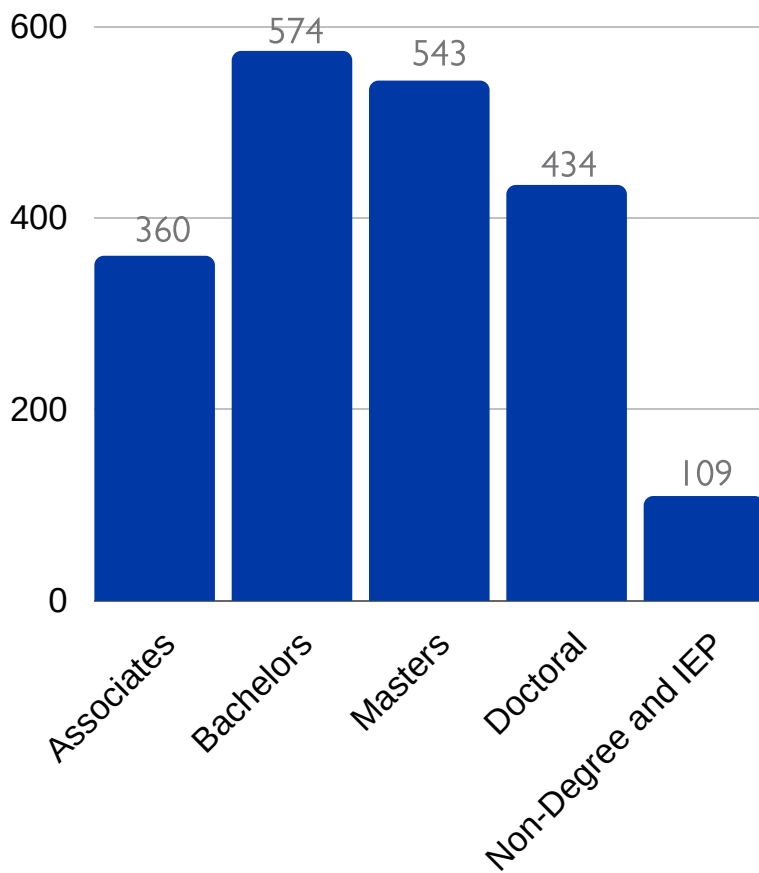
# Undergraduate International Enrollment by College



# Graduate International Enrollment by College



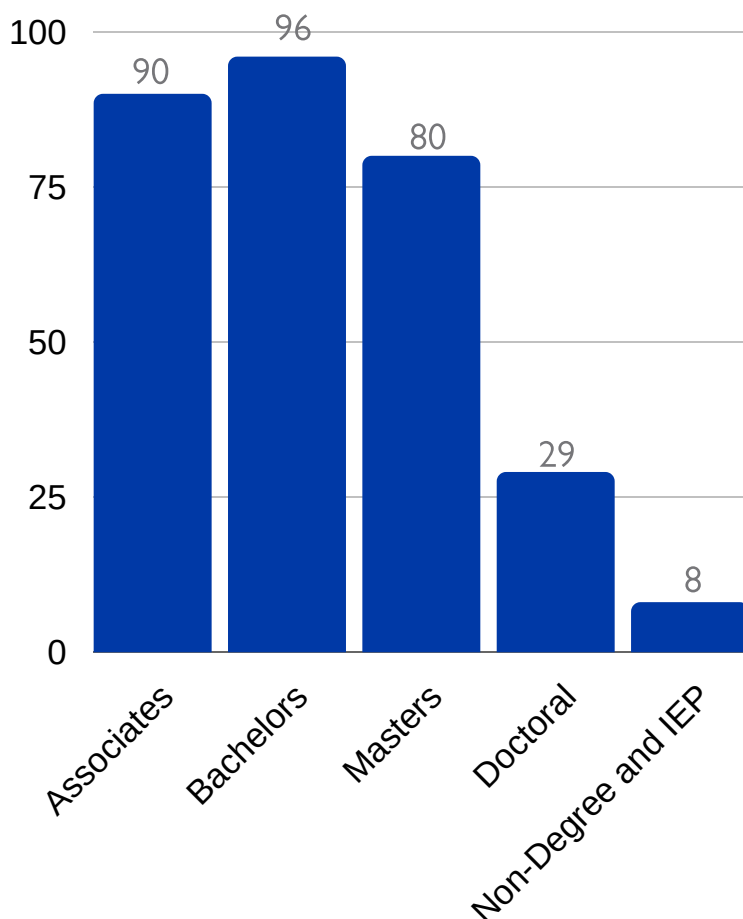

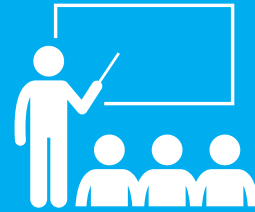

# Economic Impact of International Students

## United States

**1,095,299** international students studied at U.S. colleges and universities and contributed **\$41 billion** and supported **458,290** jobs in the U.S. economy.



For every **7** international students enrolled, **3 U.S. jobs** are created and supported by expenses on higher education, lodging, food, retail, transportation, telecommunications and health insurance.

## Georgia

International students studying in Georgia contributed **\$850.6 million** and supported **10,259** jobs to the local economy.



**2900+** International students enrolled at Georgia State University contributed **\$80.6 million** and supported **1,096** jobs in the local economy.
