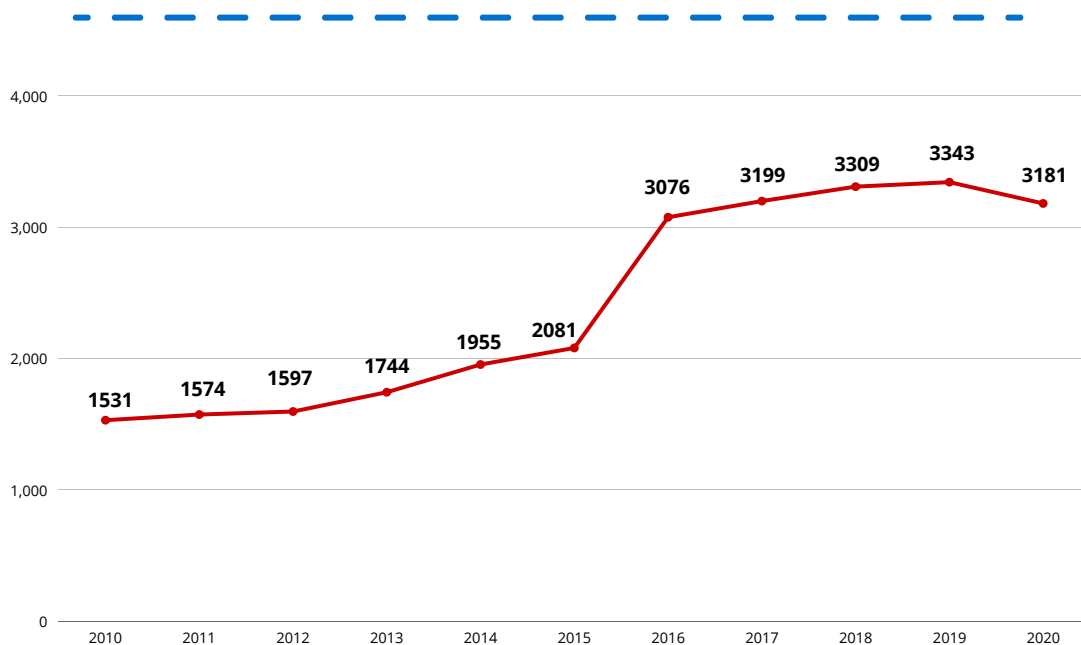
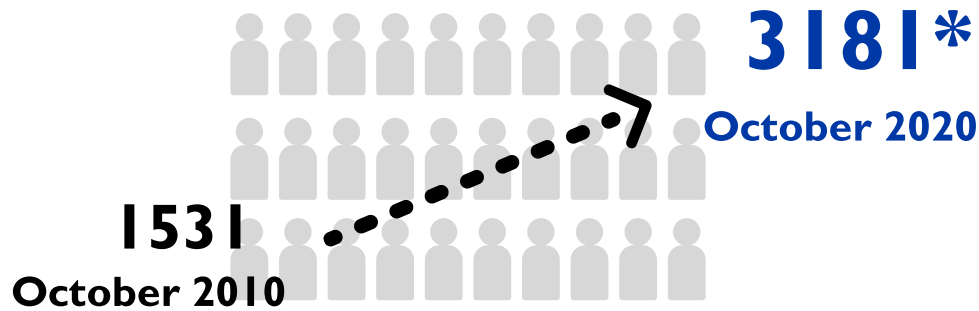

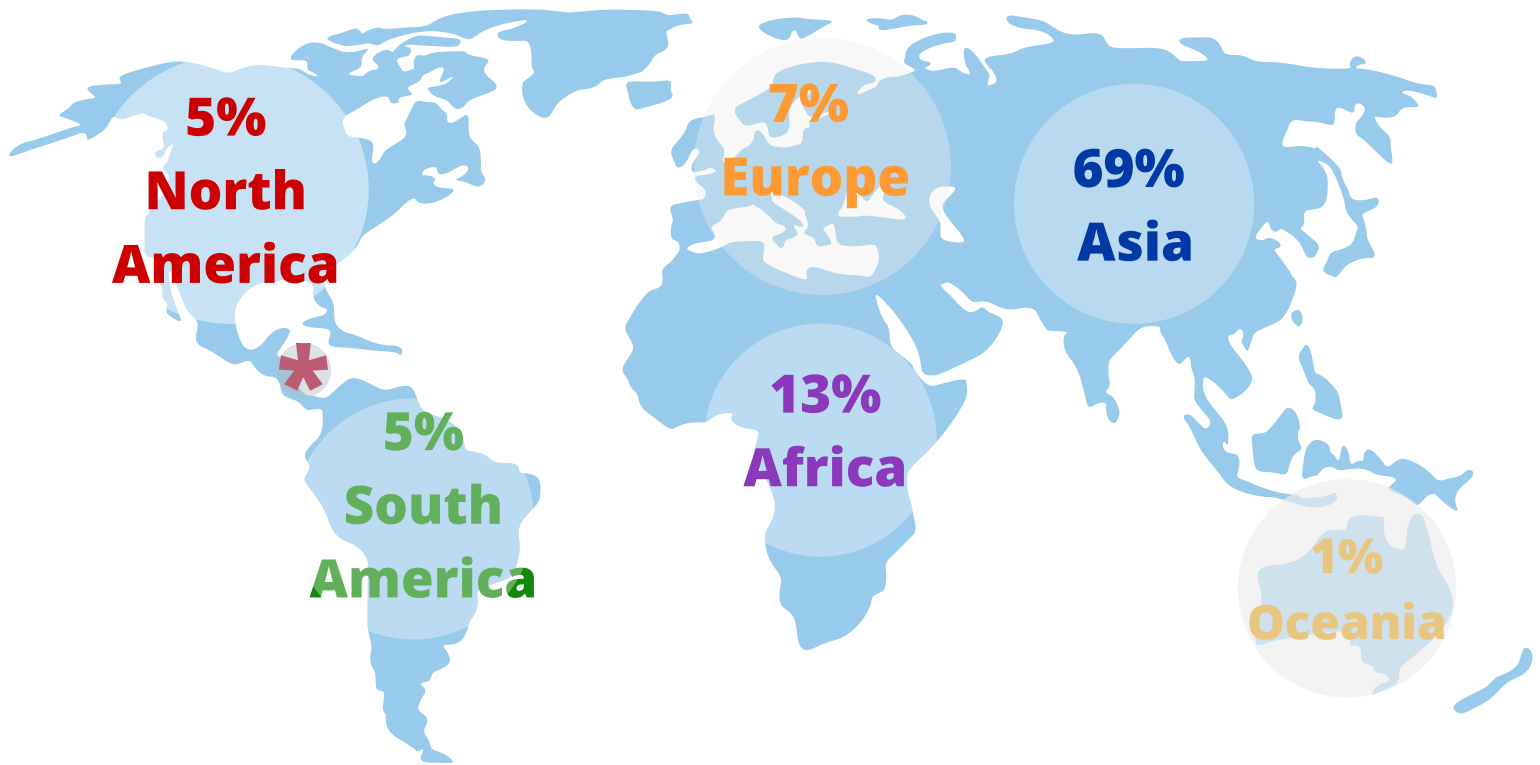

Regional Origins



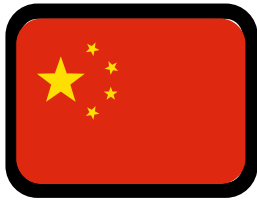

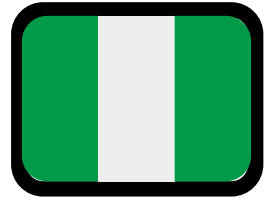

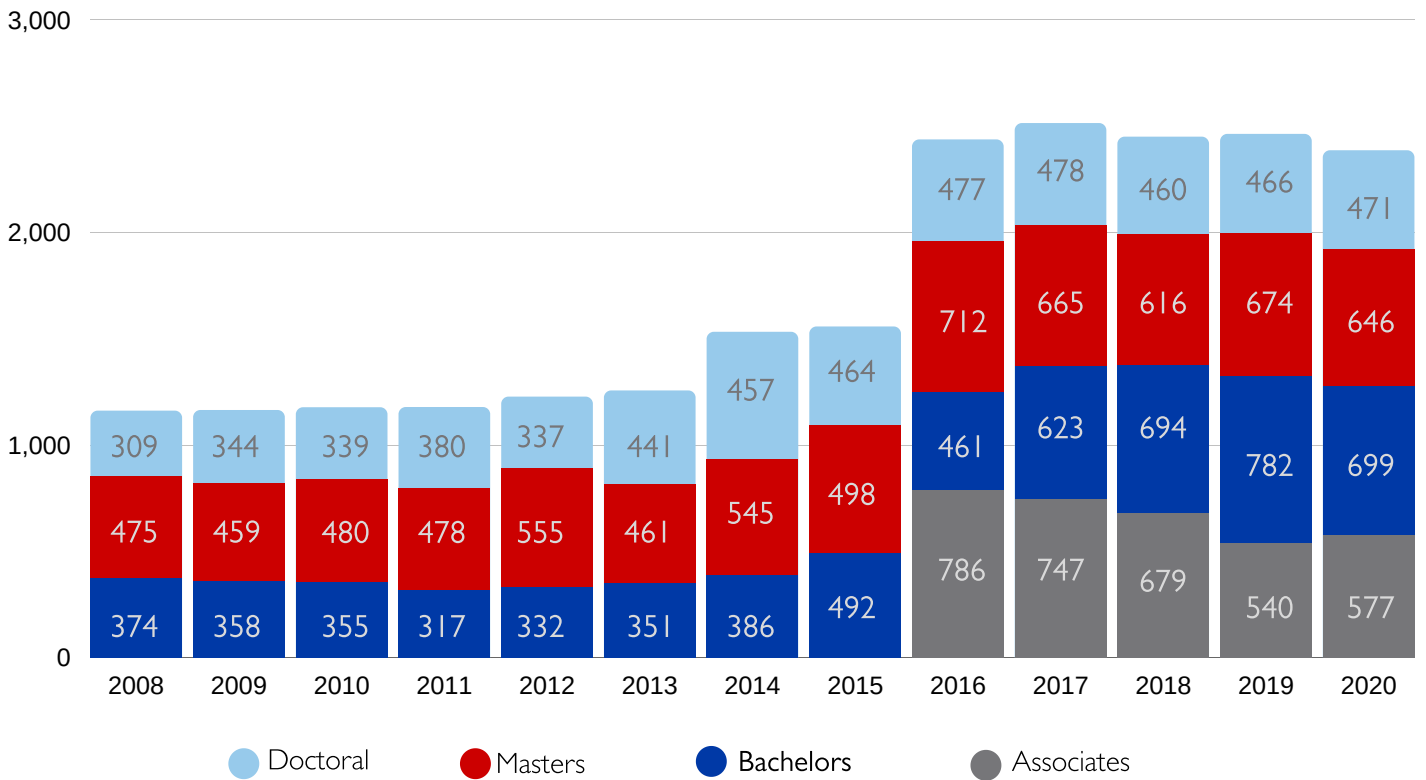

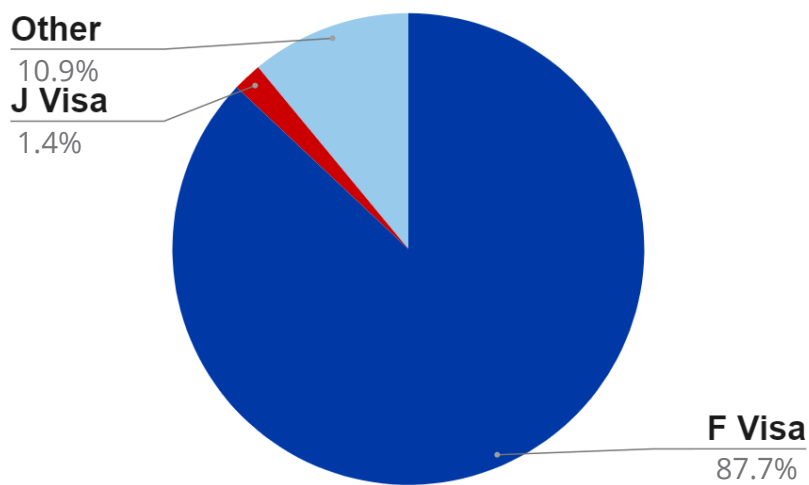

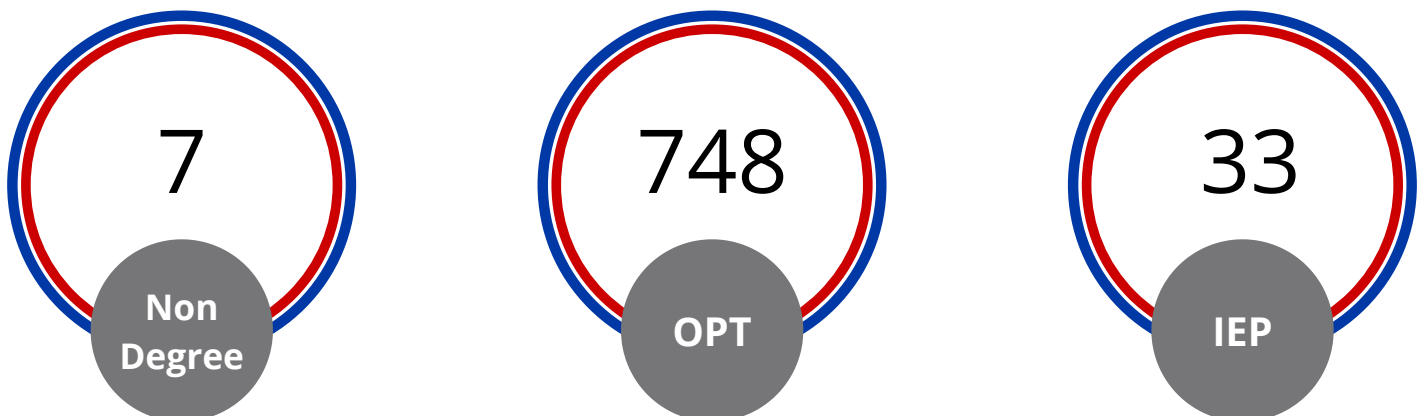
International Enrollment By Academic Level



By Visa Type

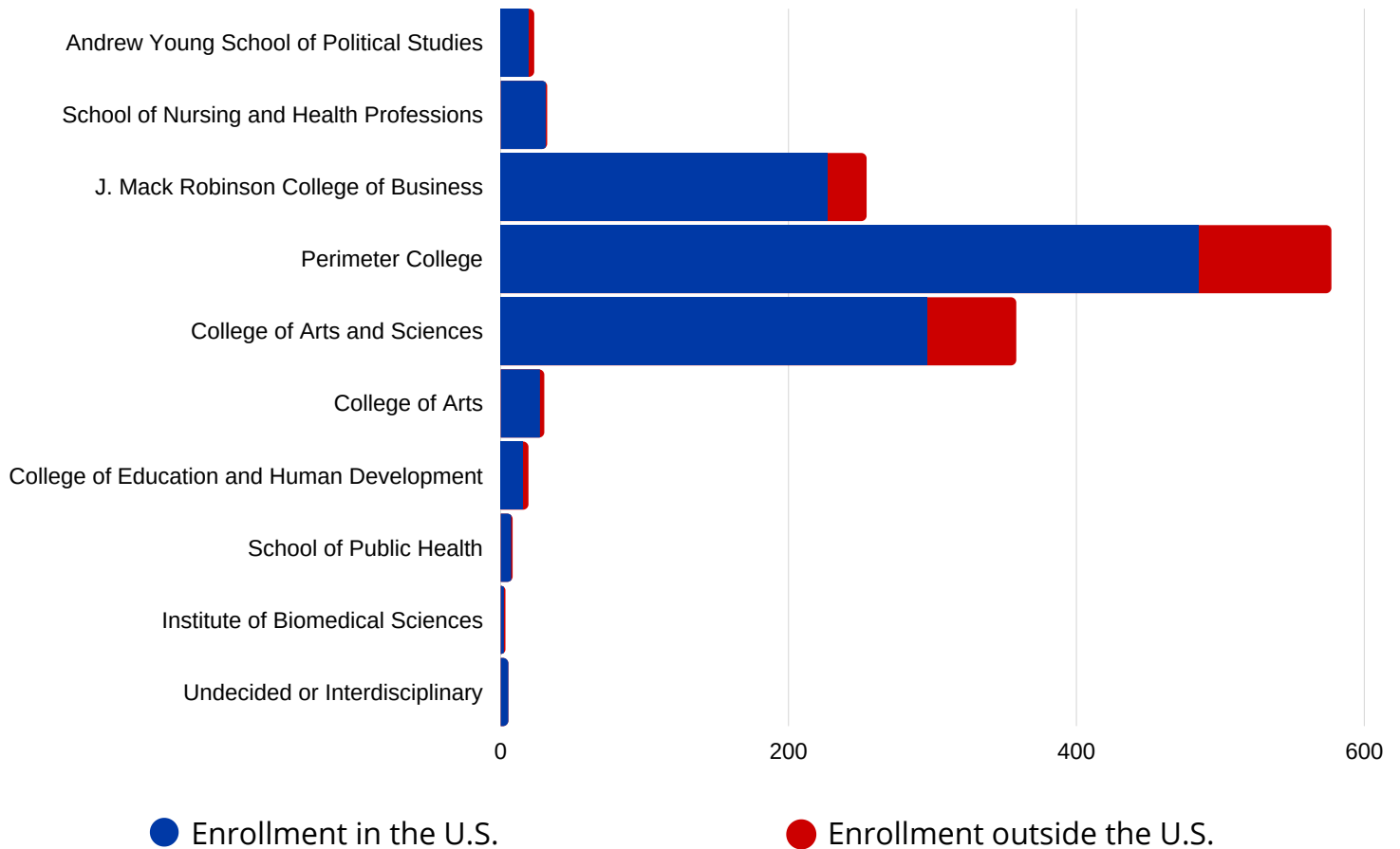

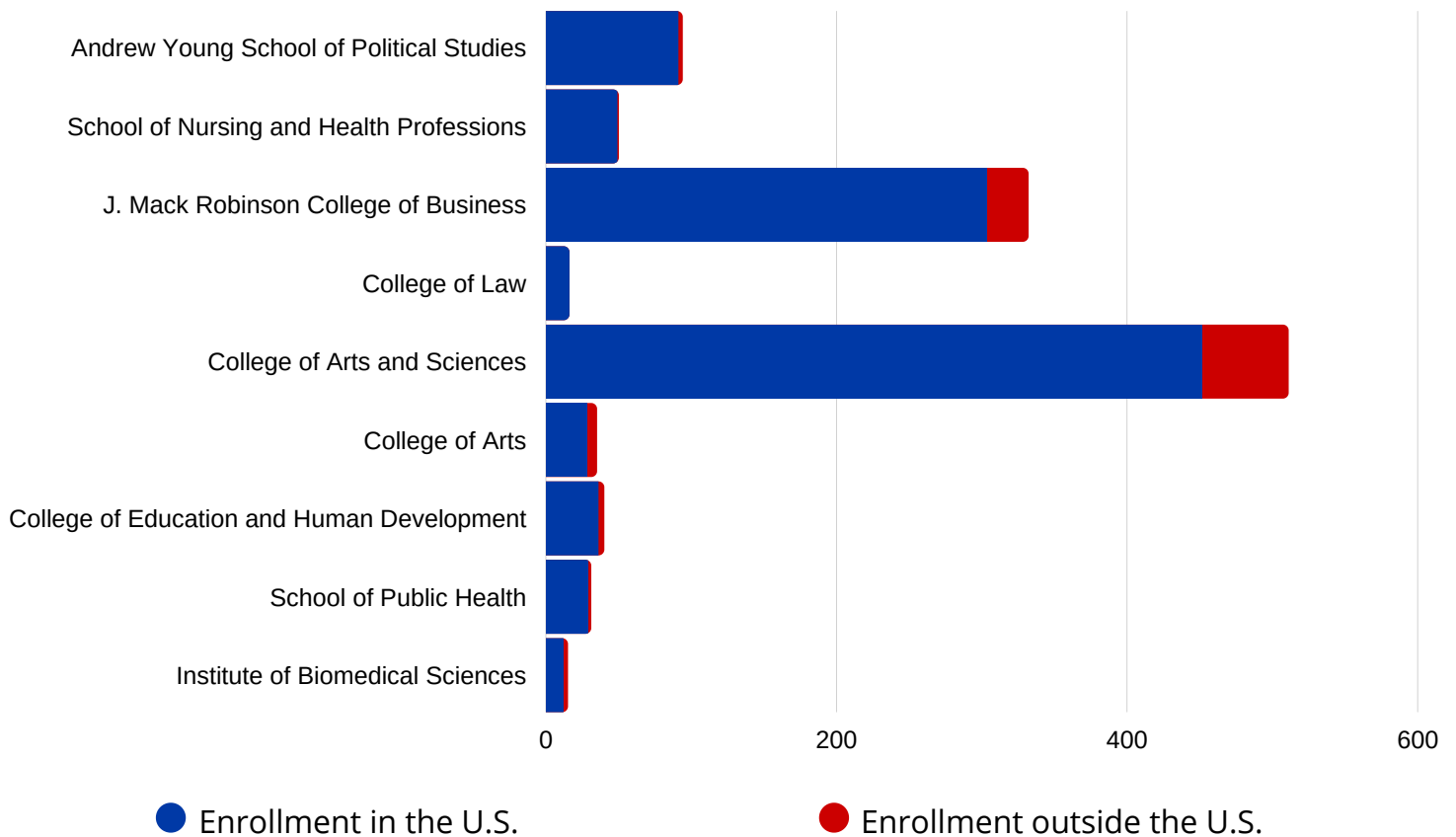

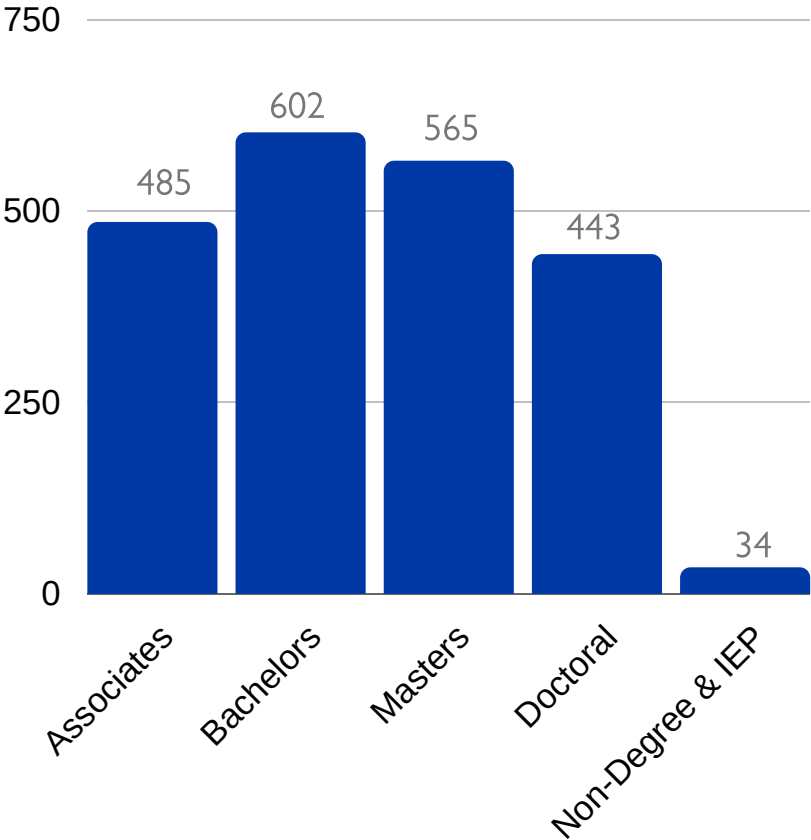
Undergraduate International Enrollment by College



Graduate International Enrollment by College

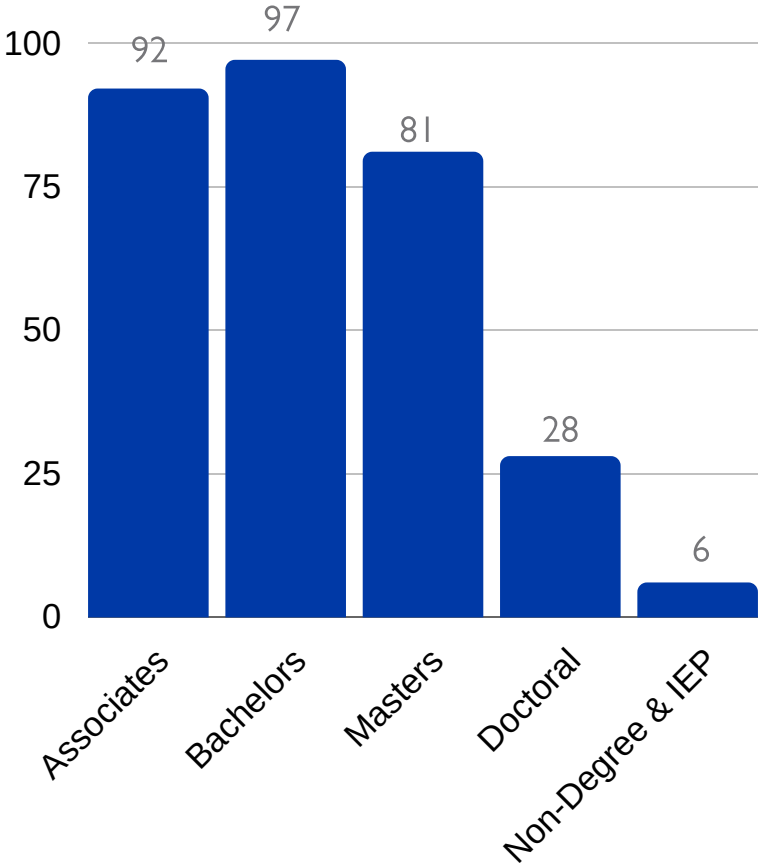


International Students Studying inside the U.S.

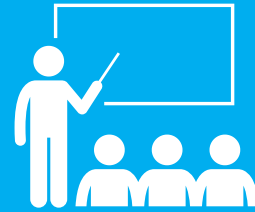

Economic Impact of International Students

United States

1,095,299 international students studied at U.S. colleges and universities and contributed **\$41 billion** and supported **458,290** jobs in the U.S. economy.



For every **7** international students enrolled, **3 U.S. jobs** are created and supported by expenses on higher education, lodging, food, retail, transportation, telecommunications and health insurance.

Georgia

International students studying in Georgia contributed **\$850.6 million** and supported **10,259** jobs to the local economy.



3100+ International students enrolled at Georgia State University contributed **\$80.6 million** and supported **1,096** jobs in the local economy.
